| Description | The investment concerns the strengthening of the adaptability of the Social Cooperative Enterprise of Collective and Social Benefit "Ecomuseum Zagori" to the new conditions of the economy and employment with the creation of 3 new job positions. Ecomuseum Zagori is an open-type museum and serves as an interpretive center for the environment and the cultural landscape of Zagori for the local community and visitors who want to get to know the place and its inhabitants. Through interpretive processes, the traditions of the region are highlighted, allowing visitors to grasp the factors and values that have shaped its uniqueness. Educational programs aim to showcase, promote, and protect the cultural and natural heritage of the broader area through an interactive narrative of the timeless relationship between people and their natural environment, while also supporting the sustainable development of the region. Ecomuseum Zagori was strengthened to continue contributing to the formation of Zagori's Tourism Identity, based on the recognition of Ecomuseums by the Regional Spatial Plan of Epirus Region in 2018 (No. ΥΠΕΝ/ΔΧΩΡΣ/78523/1208). Its goal is to increase its outward focus and networking for the sustainable development of the area. |
